

Hartville R-II Technology Plan

Hartville R-II will ensure technology is fully integrated into every aspect of the district's educational and learning environment to enrich teaching and improve performance. Students will be provided innovative learning technologies to assist in improving the quality of engagement in the excitement of learning. Faculty and staff will be trained and inspired to use instructional strategies powered by technology. District technology resources will be available to assist in the integration of technology into the process of student learning and will support new waves of innovation preparing students for the future they are creating.

The technology plan is presented to the Hartville R-II Board of Education and Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education for approval and disseminated through the district website. Evaluation of data sources is continuous and serves as the foundation for recommendations and improvements for subsequent plans submitted to the Board of Education in program review rotation.

The technology plan is aligned with the goals of the Comprehensive School Improvement Plan and includes the following strategies:

- Gather data to analyze student use and competence of technology in school.
- Provide all students with access to and instruction in relevant technological tools and resources.
- Provide on-going professional development to support relevant technological processes.
- Maintain 100% high quality teacher ratio in all programs.
- Provide avenues for students to apply technological skills in real-world situations.
- Continue to update programs to a more universal software to meet academic and career goals.
- Adopt and implement on-line safety curriculum for all students.
- Facilitate community access to technology.
- Maintain an internet site to include links for skills in technology.
- Investigate methods of technology utilization to reduce traditional tasks.
- Develop and implement a 5-year plan for rotation, replacement, and acquisition of equipment.
- Maintain technology internal and external structures to sustain accessibility.
