In these unprecedented times, we want you to know that your child's health, well-being and education are of the utmost importance to us. Starting next week, we plan to begin providing meals and school work to students.

Starting Monday March 23, 2020 we will begin providing free meals to those 18 years and younger who live in our district. Routes, serving those requesting meals to be dropped off, will run between 9:30am and 12:00pm M-F. These families should be contacted by drivers, prior to Monday, regarding more specific timing. Those who live within the city limits of Hartville or have indicated a desire to pick up food at the Hartville or Grovespring campus may do so from 10:00am to 12:00pm M-F.

School work will be distributed via at-home work packets, on Tuesdays, starting March 24, 2020. At-home packets will be distributed in the same manner in which meals are distributed. Once the work is completed please return the entire packet back in the envelope. At-home work packets may be returned to school by bus pickup or dropped off during the scheduled pick up times mentioned above.

We understand these uncertain times may bring on stress and concern. If, you have any questions, please, do not hesitate to contact your teacher or the office during school hours (8:00am - 3:00pm M-F). We take our obligation to educate your child very seriously.
