As we look forward to beginning a new basketball season it is important to notify you of the precautions we are taking to keep everyone healthy and safe. Listed below are some highlights specific to Hartville home basketball games as of the date listed above.

**Temperature checks** will be required for all visitors entering the building. Anyone with a temperature of 100 degrees or more will not be allowed to attend. Anyone with a temperature of 99.5 to 99.9 will be kept in isolation to monitor. Coaches and sponsors are asked to check participant's temperatures before arrival.

**Seating** will be separated. Home seating is on the north end and visitor seating is on the south end of both sides of the gym. Blue stadium seats are reserved for adult and family seating. Social distancing is highly encouraged. Bleacher seating is open to the public. Students sitting in the bleachers are required to sit on the "X" marks provided for social distancing OR are required to wear a mask.

**Restrooms** will be separated. Home restrooms are on the north end and visitor restrooms are on the south end of the gym.

**Masks** are encouraged especially in transit and in places where social distancing is difficult. Masks are required for students sitting closely together in the student section.

**Water** coolers and cups will not be provided. Participants are responsible for providing their own individual source of hydration.

**Water fountains** will not be accessible.

**Concessions** will be available. Workers will wear masks and gloves. Money collection and food dispensary will be kept separate. The line for the concession stand will allow for social distancing.
